

## FOR CONVERSATION:

1. While on the Mount of Olives how did Jesus prepare Himself for His own mortality? (Luke 22:39-41)
2. Jesus was not angry or without hope but was simply honest with God. How do His words and the way in which He prayed in vv. 42-44 convey an intense outpouring to the Father?
3. The fundamental concern of Jesus was something other than avoidance of suffering and preservation of His life. From v. 42, identify that concern.
4. How would you define the relationship of Jesus to the Father? During His earthly mission, did Jesus act by His own authority or did He relinquish autonomy in favor of the Father's plan and will? (John 7:28, 14:31)
5. While Jesus was laboring hard in prayer, the disciples were sound asleep. When Jesus returned to them, what did He say and why? (v. 45-46)
6. How likely is one to resist temptation without asking for divine help? (v. 45-46, Mark 14:38)
7. When we pray, how might we use the pattern set by Jesus?
