1. What did the psalmist ask God when he cried out in Psalm 22:1? Who else asked this same question (Matthew 27:46)? From these two examples, do you think we have permission to seek answers from God during tough times?
2. How does Psalm 22:2 describe the intensity and frequency of the psalmist's prayers? Did he receive an immediate answer from God?
3. During God's silence, how much do you think the Psalmist's confidence in Him was bolstered by acknowledging His holiness and knowing His past faithfulness (Psalm 22:3-5, Judges 3:9)?
4. In Psalm 22:6-8, what words were used to honestly express vulnerability?
5. From the preceding verses, what happens to human dignity when people reject God and His truths?
6. Through it all, did the psalmist remain close to God (Psalm 22:10)?
7. How can we pursue the truths of God's sovereignty, faithfulness, and trustworthiness to sustain our trust in God even when He seems silent (Psalm 22:9-11)?
