1. Identify the elements of Isaiah's vision in 6:1-4 that provide clarity about the Lord's attributes.
2. Discuss how Isaiah's vision of God's glory anticipates that of Christ. (6:1, John 1:14, 12:37-41)
3. In 6:5 Isaiah confesses his sins. How does this serve as a model for us? When pondering this question, think about having an honest conversation with God.
4. Verses 6:6-7 speak about the cleansing of Isaiah's sin. This is God's grace personally applied. Describe how this applies to us.
5. Did Isaiah respond willingly or reluctantly to the Lord's question about whom He should send? (6:8)
6. We are called by God, as was Isaiah, to be active servants in His kingdom. How would you describe your role in this undertaking? (6:8)
7. Isaiah had an encounter with the Lord that affected him profoundly. Think comprehensively about your ENCOUNTER with Jesus Christ and describe how EVERYTHING changed for you.
