passages from Exodus - Pastor Troy Norling

1. God took Moses' characteristics and molded them until they were suited to his purposes. Does knowing this make a difference in your understanding of God's purpose in your life? How might God use your own abilities and strengths to do His will?
2. Aaron was a great assistant to Moses, but he was weak as a leader (gave in to Golden calf). What traits of leading or following has God placed in you? How might God use those traits in you at home, work, in the Church?
3. Miriam was a quick thinker under pressure, and was able to lead well at times. However, she openly criticized her own brother's leadership (Moses) because she was jealous. What are some possible negative motives for disagreeing with leadership around you (at home, work, church)? What could Miriam have done differently and how can you use that in your life?
4. Joshua had modeled himself after Moses' leadership. You are part of the chain of God's ongoing work in the world. Who is your Moses (who are you modeling yourself after)? Who is your Joshua (who are you investing in)? How important is God to those you want to be like? Do those who are watching you see God reflected in every area of your life? What are(s) can you improve on? What areas are going well?
